"Outside-the-season-of-sport"-thereisatpresentatotalban on any contact between coach and high school athlete "outside- the-season-of-sport." This puts some sports at an advantage (Fall sports where a coach can work with kids in the summer immediately before the season of sport) over other sports. It gives non-school programs an advantage over school programs.

Is there any interest in allowing some very limited contact outside the "season-of-sport"? Some ideas:

- o 8 hours per week maximum
- o 14 day break from end of season (last day of final contact)
- o 3-4 player maximum in workouts
- o Minimum 2 days off during each week
- o Live periods 10/1-11/1; 12/1-2/1; 3/1-6/1
